

FINANCIAL CIRCUMSTANCES FUND – NAMIBIA

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. The Namibian Air Traffic Controllers' Association (NATCA) applied for the Financial Circumstances Fund (FCF).

2. DISCUSSION

- 2.1. The requested amount is \$433.10 USD.
- 2.2. This is a membership fee 2024-2025.
- 2.3. The Namibian association was up for termination at conference 2024 in Singapore for the outstanding amount of \$861.14 USD. The directors agreed to postpend the termination until the regional meeting. The Association requested to extend the deadline until January 1st, 2025, and was granted the extension by the Executive Board. The association was able to pay 50% of the outstanding amount and paid 406.23 USD.
- 2.4. The reason:
"We have formed a new Air Traffic Controllers Association executive committee, the outstanding amount was a communication oversight by the previous executive committee, some of whom are no longer employed as ATCs so there was a poor handover of our financial obligations towards IFATCA."

1. CONCLUSION

- 1.1. The Namibian Air Traffic Controllers' Association is requesting \$406.23 USD in order to avoid a suspension.

2. RECOMMENDATIONS

- 2.1. It is recommended to approve the requested amount of \$406.23 USD to be paid from the FCF towards the balance 2024-2025.
